

Thank you for choosing OakLeaf Pediatrics for your child's care.

It is the OakLeaf Pediatrics practice to follow *Bright Futures* clinical practice guidelines as recognized by the American Academy of Pediatrics. *Bright Futures* identifies prevention and health promotion for infants, children, adolescents, and their families.

During each of your child's preventive care visits, the following services may be performed:

- Physical Exam – which includes (as applicable) looking at your child's physical development including height, weight, head circumference, body mass index and blood pressure. An exam is done of your child to see expected developmental milestones.
- Hearing screening – a screening exam is performed
- Vision screening – a vision screening exam is performed with a machine to assist with identifying any visual concerns your child may be having.
- Developmental and Behavioral Health – which may include a questionnaire asking you specific questions about your child's learning development and behavior.

We are notifying you that each of the services above may have an additional associated charge that we will bill your insurance carrier. We perform these tasks to provide a FULL assessment of your child and want to ensure that your child is fully assessed during our visit with you.

During the visit, your child may have also some acute conditions that may need to be addressed with the provider. To save you time in making another appointment and based on time, your provider may be able to address these during your visit. Some of these services may be above and beyond the physical – and there may also be an associated office visit charge. Examples of this would be treatment for an ear infection or strep throat.
